Bio

Selu Herraiz (they/he) is a trans-disciplinary artist, musician and film-maker. Cofounder of Aldarrax Label and art-director of Rota, –weird music festival. Member of AADK Spain, a platform based in the rural environment of Ricote Valley (Spain). Selu studied Electronic Engineering. They practice art as an excuse to inhabit and seeks to integrate the creative act into daily life in order to activate social transformation and stimulate critical thinking. Specially focused in sound, they combine their personal research with the design of educational experiences, approaching creation in close relation with territory and communities.

STATEMENT

Currently Selu Herraiz develops artistic work mainly on the fields of sound art and experimental music, approaching creation in close relation with territory and communities. As a sound artist, They are interested in deep, active and respectful listening to the territory and the voices that inhabit it. They collect field recordings focusing on social and environmental listening. He studies topics such as ritual, animism, healing processes and food.

Selu develops an experimental sound research and production project that reflects on the contemporary relationships between daily life and ritual. The thin boundaries between science and magic are guestioned through sonority, investigating new symbologies in the way they affect the human subconscious and determine our possible paths for transformation. In a poetic way, they navigate the interstices between the conscious and the unconscious, ancient wisdom and current knowledge; where physical and spiritual reality are synchronized in common rhythms giving rise to symbolic worlds that help to create new imaginaries about a not only human habitat. In the music scene, under the pseudonym Munda, they creates a sound that travels from the primitive and raw to psychedelic electronica, clearly permeated by rhythms and harmonies of traditional Mediterranean cultures and captivated by the Sufi heritage that flourished in the valleys of southern Spain during the Al-Andalus era. Selu works with DIY instruments, field recordings, analog synthesizers and digital software to give rise to compositions in which dark environments and noisy cinematic scenes emerge. sometimes accompanied by slow and mantric polyrhythms that are an invitation to trance.
